Nicolas Carnot is director for economic studies and syntheses at Insee, the French National Statistical Institute. His career as a senior civil servant includes positions in the national economic administration as well as inside international organisations (European Commission, International Monetary Fund). Among others, he served as chief auditor at the *Cour des comptes*, fiscal policy advisor in DG ECFIN, and deputy director and head of economic forecasts in the French Treasury. A graduate from the *Ecole Polytechnique* and *ENSAE Paris Tech*, he co-authored the reference textbook *Economic Forecasting and Policy* (Palgrave Macmillan, 2nd ed., 2011).
